3 Day Kruger Safari

Day 1: Gauteng – Kruger Park

We depart from Johannesburg between 06h00 – 08h00 to allow for various collection points. Our route takes us through the wide open spaces of the Highveld, down the escarpment and through the scenic Lowveld area. We stop for lunch en-route (own expense) and reach the Kruger National Park in the afternoon.

(Guests flying into Nelspruit's Kruger Mpumalanga airport, wishing to join the shuttle, need to land between 11h00 & 12h45 and be aware that they may have to wait a little for the shuttle to arrive from Johannesburg. Private transfers are available to guests booked on flights at alternative times at an additional charge. Guests flying directly into Skukuza airport will be transferred free of charge.)

After settling in to our accommodations, you go out on your first game drive which is a SAN PARKS sunset drive. A sunset drive affords you the opportunity to see nocturnal animals that are more active at night and the Park's rangers are allowed to return after the normal gate closing times. Note that these drives take place in one of the Kruger Park's vehicles with a Park's ranger. This is not a private game drive and there may be other guests on this drive. (Children under 6 years of age are not permitted on open vehicle drives.)

Dinner is a three course meal, served al fresco at our camp. Wine is served with dinner but guests are welcome to bring along additional / alternative drinks which can be purchased at the shop.

Day 2: Full day in the Park

Safaris are all about early mornings, getting out there and seeing animals! After an early wake-up call (the time varies according to the seasons and park gate opening times) we have tea or coffee & muffins. We then set off on the morning safari which will take approximately 3-4 hours. Your guide has an intimate knowledge of the park, which contributes a great deal towards brilliant sightings!

On returning to Camp, breakfast/brunch will be ready at our camp. You then have time to enjoy a swim, catch up on some sleep, visit the park shop which includes African curios, general food items and drinks, take a walk around the camp, or simply relax! Be sure to bring along your binoculars!

After a siesta we set off on the afternoon game drive. We conduct all our game drives in specially adapted 4x4 open game drive vehicles to allow our guests the best possible vantage point.

We share safari stories at the camp fire under the stars after dinner served at our camp.

Day 3: Kruger Park – Gauteng

The sun rises over our final day in the Park and we have one last chance to find the animals that have eluded us thus far. After breakfast we return to Johannesburg. The drive back takes at least 6 hours and guests are advised to sleep over in Johannesburg on this night.

(Guests flying out of Nelspruit, wishing to still join the morning game drive and the shuttle going through Nelspruit, should book flights departing from 13h30 onwards. Any earlier flights will result in missing the morning game drive and having to book a private transfer at an additional charge.)

Optional Excursion (free of charge)

We offer an optional excursion to visit select attractions along the Panorama Route in all our Kruger Safaris of 3 days or longer. We stop in one of the small towns en-route for lunch (excluded) and visit attractions such as the Blyde River Canyon, Three Rondavels, Lisbon Waterfalls and God's Window. We depart Camp at around 11h00 and will be back between 17h00 and 18h00. This excursion is available free of charge, replaces one of the afternoon drives and will be co-ordinated by our staff while you are on safari with us. (Kindly note that this excursion is not available on the first or last day of your Safari due to time constrictions)

Safari Options:

1 October 2015 – 30 September 2016

Classic Kruger - R 7910.00 per person

Accommodation is in en-suite chalets with beds, linen, towels & soap. These chalets have a small fridge, air conditioning and mosquito proofing on the doors & windows.

Budget Kruger - R 6630.00 per person

Accommodation is in huts with beds, linen, towels & soap. Ablutions are shared and serviced very regularly. These huts have a small fridge, air-conditioning and mosquito proofing on the doors & windows.

Camping Kruger - R 5450.00 per person

Spacious dome tent equipped with beds, mattresses, duvets, pillows, towels, amenities and an electrical power point. Ablutions are shared and serviced very regularly. Guests are reminded to bring along a flashlight.

1 October 2016 – 30 September 2017

Classic Kruger - R 8770.00 per person

Accommodation is in en-suite chalets with beds, linen, towels & soap. These chalets have a small fridge, air conditioning and mosquito proofing on the doors & windows.

Budget Kruger - R 7360.00 per person

Accommodation is in huts with beds, linen, towels & soap. Ablutions are shared and serviced very regularly. These huts have a small fridge, air-conditioning and mosquito proofing on the doors & windows.

Camping Kruger - R 6060.00 per person

Spacious dome tent equipped with beds, mattresses, duvets, pillows, towels, amenities and an electrical power point. Ablutions are shared and serviced very regularly. Guests are reminded to bring along a flashlight.

Included:

- Professional drivers/guides (FGASA registered – Field Guides Association of Southern Africa)
- Meals as specified per itinerary
- All day drives in the Kruger National Park in an open game drive vehicle
- SAN PARKS sunset drive (All Kruger Safari guests over 6 years of age)
- All entry fees and daily conservation levies
- Accommodation as per chosen option
- Wine with dinner in the Kruger National Park
- Optional Excursion

Excluded:

- Meals not specified in itinerary
- Guests are welcome to bring their own drinks to dinner, which can be purchased at the Park's shop
- Items of a personal nature
- Gratuities
- Pick up and/or drop off in Johannesburg / Pretoria South / Nelspruit (KMIA)

Notes:

On our safaris, we make use of facilities and accommodation situated inside the Kruger National Park and do not stay outside the Kruger, unless forced to do so because of availability.

Classic - We have a permanent camp in Skukuza, which is also where our open game drive vehicles are based.

Budget & Camping - We have a permanent camp in Pretoriuskop, which is also where our open game drive vehicles are based. Safaris with accommodation in multiple rest camps are available on request.

It is important to note that this is not a private safari and more than likely there will be other guests joining you on the game drive vehicles, air-conditioned mini bus transfer vehicles as well as in the dining facility.

Please note that sunset game drive times are subject to change and availability on the day. These drives are conducted by SAN PARKS, by one of their rangers and in one of their vehicles. There will most likely be other guests on this drive. Children under 6 years of age are not allowed on SAN Parks open game drive vehicles.

Although we welcome children on our safaris, we reserve the right not to allow younger children on our normal game drives. This will be entirely up to the guide's discretion and will be in order to ensure a pleasurable game drive for all our guests (including the parents). We do not offer babysitting and as such one of the parents will have to stay behind to watch the children. Private game drives for families can be arranged at an extra charge.

Note that as of 1 June 2015 strict rules for families traveling with children under 18, entering and departing South Africa, will be enforced by the South African Department of Home Affairs in an effort to curb child trafficking. Complying with these regulations will be the client's responsibility and we cannot be held responsible for any costs incurred by non-compliance.

Guests flying out of OR Tambo Airport on the last day are reminded to not book any flights earlier than 19h00 (domestic) or 20h00 (international) in order to give us enough time to get you to the airport. We recommend that you rather stay over in Johannesburg if possible. Since we cannot guarantee our arrival time in Johannesburg on the last day we will not be held responsible for re-imbursing flight tickets, should we arrive later than expected. Private transfers for guests with early flights can be arranged in advance at an extra charge.
